HOW DO I MOVE UP AN ENGLISH LEVEL?

To make certain student's English classes are challenging, they are assessed throughout their course. The standard of the student's classwork and their test results at the end of each 5 week session help determine their next class level. We expect it will take 10 weeks to progress from one level to the next.
