● Academic English Preparation 1 (AEP1)

Successful completion of AEP2 provides direct-entry to various Certificate, Diploma and Advanced Diploma courses, as well as entry into AEP3.

● Academic English Preparation 3 (AEP3)

AEP3 is designed to prepare students for studying at university. The focus is on essay writing, research skills, critical thinking, as well as academic speaking, reading and listening. Successful completion of AEP3 provides students with direct-entry into their chosen Undergraduate or Postgraduate courses at our various partner universities.

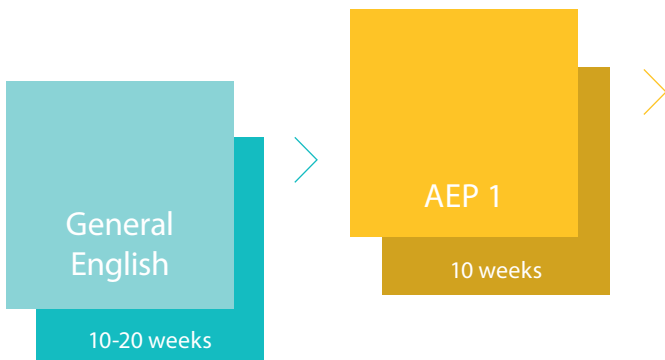

Intermediate with 60% pass mark

with 75% pass mark

AEP3: IELTS 5.5 (no band lower than 5.0) or
Completion of one module of GE Upper
Intermediate with 75% pass mark
